General Session: Prescription Alert!Presenter: Dave Sallengs, KASPER
An update on Prescription Drug Abuse and Diversion. We will discuss the problems with controlled substance abuse and diversion, at the national level as well as the KASPER system, how it works, general information on PMPs (including what states have them). As coders we will look at What, When, and How to document & report (ICD-9) controlled substance abuse.

General Session: 2009 Medicare Updates.....Presenter: Lindy Lady, National Government Services
In this session we will discuss Medicare changes for 2009 and any new related topics as they apply to coders, billers, compliance officers and office managers.

General Session: Interventional RadiologyPresenter: Tammy Rannells, CPC, CCP, CPC-H, CCP-H, CCP-AS
In this session we will discuss what Interventional Radiology procedures entail and who performs them, how to identify and code the three components of these services and discuss the vascular systems and vascular families.

General Session: How to Engage The Patient In Coding and Collection Activities Within an Office.....Presenter: Patrick Padgett, KMA
We will discuss how important it is for coders, billers and other office personnel to keep in mind the patient's point of view about billing, claims, and insurance, and how that point of view can impact a medical practice or hospital. We will also discuss how KMA works with billing personnel to track global billing issues that can be taken to the payers for action.

In this session we will strengthen your auditing skills by reviewing all aspects of E/M documentation. We will also discuss the three key components.....History, Examination, Medical Decision Making plus ancillary CPT and ICD-9 coding.
