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## “Disaster Recovery: Who’s Going to Bail Out Healthcare?”

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**General Session: 2010 Medicare Updates.....Presenter: Lindy Lady, National Government Services**  
In this session we will discuss Medicare changes for 2010 and any new related topics as they apply to coders, billers, compliance officers and office managers.

**General Session: “Tough Solutions for Tough Times”.....Presenter: Lyman Terry, Regional Vice President, GLA Collection Company**  
Only 25% of medical offices have policies in place to collect at the time of service. This session will look at solutions for setting up point of service collection policies. We will identify problem areas in the coding/billing process, as well as specify strategies that will give clarity to your employees dealing with patients.

**General Session: “Coding for Chronic Disease Management” .....Presenter: Renee Girdler, MD**  
This presentation will provide an overview of the Chronic Care Model created by Ed Wagner, M. D. of Seattle’s MacColl Institute for Healthcare Innovation, which identifies the essential elements of a health care system that encourages high-quality chronic disease care. The Chronic Care Model focuses on improving health care for patients with chronic illness by implementing a patient-centered model of care. Components include–1) clinical information systems, 2) decision support, 3) self-management support 4) delivery system design 5) organization of the health system and 6) community resources. Run charts will be utilized to show how U of L has made improvements in the management and care of patients with diabetes. Documentation issues and rules for coding chronic diseases will be incorporated into this session.

**General Session: : Is America Ready for 'Reform'? And What Does 'Reform' Mean?" ..... Presenters: Colleen McKinley, JD –Edward Schoenbaechler, JD**  
In this session we will discuss "Single Payer and Other Health Care Reform Proposals: “Reform or Socialized Medicine?” We will discuss a description of different plans that call for “reforming” health care in the US and paying for healthcare vs. ways to make the system more efficient. We will also discuss the “hard questions” our healthcare professionals face: every dollar saved in "health care" is a dollar taken away from a provider, what is likely to become law and how this will affect our healthcare professionals: certified coders, billers, and practice managers.

**General Session: ICD-10-CM Countdown.....Presenter: Sherry Thomas, CCP, CCP-AS**  
This presentation will provide an overview regarding the new ICD-10-CM code set as well as the guidelines, structure of this new coding system, documentation issues and auditing. Hands on exercises will be provided and each attendee will receive a copy of the current version of the ICD-10-CM book.
